Information for 2019 Boys Camp Training Track

What is Training Track?

Training track is a developmental program designed to bring up counselors and leaders from within the camp. Students in the correct age group will be paired with a counselor and shadow him throughout the week. Students in the training track will be given specific responsibilities to help serve the camp. The purpose of training track is to identify campers who are interested in working at the camp and developing them into servant leaders who can lead others to Christ.

Who can be part of the Training Track?

Boys who:

- Have completed, 10th, 11th, or 12th grades may be eligible for the Training Track but each must apply and be accepted to be on the Training Track
- Are seeking to walk daily in their relationship with God
- Are interested in growing in their personal relationship with God through Jesus Christ
- Are interested in learning more about who they are in Christ and who He has created them to be
- Want to develop their leadership skills to serve God
- Want to explore the possibility of serving on the Boys Camp Staff in the future
- Must be recommended * (*see below)

Other Requirements

Each boy needs to be recommended by current camp staff or church leadership.

In addition, each boy will need to provide additional references to be checked by camp director.
